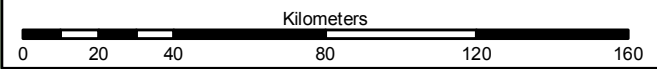

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Attention regarding to new Counties and Payams: The 5 Counties shown on this map have been split up into 12 Counties newly defined and named: Baliel, Fashoda, Longechuk, Luakpiny (Nasir), Mabaan, Maiwut, Malakal, Manyo, Malut, Panyikango, Renk, Ulang. These 12 Counties comprises now 73 Payams (formerly 23). To IMU OCHA knowledge no digital data set exists that is visualizing the location of these newly defined administrative units.
